#### INTRODUCTION

The present Contribution is aimed at filling a long-felt need for a reference work which would enable students of the flora of the Rocky Mountain region to quickly locate areas in Wyoming from which botanical collections have been made. It is the result of accumulated notes which have been made from specimen sheets deposited mainly in the Rocky Mountain Herbarium.

In years past, when most labels were laboriously hand-written in multiple sets, it frequently happened that only a minimum of information as to the locality of the collection was given, and this has resulted in a considerable amount of time spent in looking up pertinent data from field books and old maps.

Another source of confusion and error has been the changing of county boundaries and the addition of new counties within the State, so that even when the county has been mentioned in the data given with a specimen collected before 1921, when the last county adjustments were made, there is a possibility that this information is not reliable.

Various individuals have contributed generously to this project:
Dr. Aven Nelson, who has answered numerous questions from his recollections of early collecting trips; Dr. E. D. Merrill, who kindly supplied the writer with notes and a sketch map of his collecting trips through Wyoming in 1900 and 1901; Dr. T. A. Larson, Head of the University of Wyoming Department of History, who contributed the maps showing the evolution of the present county system; and numerous students and other residents of the State who have supplied local data from their knowledge of certain areas. To all of these the writer wishes to express his thanks for aiding in the solution of a vexing problem.

It is not claimed that the present list is complete, even as regards postoffices, hamlets, and even small towns. It does, however, include all those localities which have been mentioned on the thousands of specimens which have been studied by the writer and his associates during the past fifteen years while this list was being accumulated, and it embodies numerous notes made by the late Dr. Edwin Blake Payson of this institution while he was actively engaged in his well known researches.



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



# A NOTE REGARDING WYOMING STREAM NAMES

Much of the history and romance of Wyoming is associated with the naming of the streams and rivers which lie within its borders. Those interested in this phase of our nomenclature will find that it has been treated very fully in the series of articles entitled "Wyoming Stream Names" by Dee Linford, in Wyoming Wild Life, 1942-1943.

As pointed out by Linford, there has been an unfortunate duplication of stream names in Wyoming; and since it is impractical to give all these duplications in the list to follow which includes only those which are likely to be encountered in botanical collections, below is given a list of those most often duplicated and the number of streams bearing each name.
