Explanations of process and technique:

Constructed in 2005, the piece is made of 2x3inch plates of copper, plexiglass, brass, steel, and wood; all held together at different heights and directions by nuts and bolts.

Inspiration or intent behind the piece:

A single note drifts high above, joined by others, one by one, until the serenade is full of vibrant sound. "Serenade for Winds II" is the second, sculptural variation work by Tina McCarty, inspired by Mozart's "Serenade for Winds."
